The Winery

Chapel Hill Winery is just 45 minutes south of Adelaide and situated at the Northern end of the McLaren Vale wine region. Perched on the edge of the spectacular Onkaparinga Gorge the focal point of our property is the 150 year old stone chapel. Under the guidance of winemakers Michael Fragos and Bryn Richards, Chapel Hill strives to craft wines with purity and balance that articulate the wonderful charm of McLaren Vale.

The Vintage

Below average winter rainfall resulted in an early commencement to the growing season. A warmer than average summer, with no extended periods of extreme heat, resulted in a condensed vintage. Vibrant fruit flavours and acidity were still prevalent and the resultant wines were both varietal and textural.

The Wine

The true beauty of Pinot Grigio is discovered within its chalky mouthfeel and delicate fruit flavours. Adelaide Hills finesse also breathes another dimension to this variety.

The 2015 release displays green pear, fresh herbs and lemongrass flavours. Opting for a drier style allows the lingering “crunchy” palate to be proudly showcased, which ensures that this wine is refreshing, delicious and interesting.
