



Brouilly Domaine des Nazins

History and terroir:

Loïc DE LA PERRIERE runs Domaine des Nazins. The DE LA PERRIERE family is one of the oldest in the Beaujolais and has been involved in wine for over four hundred years. The Estate mainly extends over two parcels, one near the hamlet of Les Nazins and the other in the hamlet of Polanche.

Tasting:

Made from 50-year-old vines, this wine is a dark red colour and releases intense aromas of cherries and other red berries, along with a hint of vegetal. It totally fills the mouth with its fruity aromas and reveals its good tannin structure. Serve with starters or whiter meats. We recommend to taste this wine at 14-15 °C.
