



Brouilly Pisse Vieille

History and terroir :

The name comes from an old legend that's quite juicy when it's told in dialect. It's about an old woman who emerged from confession and mistook the priest's advice. She understood "Don't piss any more, old woman!", when he actually said "Don't sin any more, old woman!". After a week of suffering, she returned to see her confessor", who cried out "you've got it all wrong 'pisse vieille' (A play on words between "Piss, old lady" and "you silly old bat")". So she relieved herself there and then in the place that now bears this quaint name.

Tasting :

This is a chewy, hearty, very aromatic wine. Pisse Vieille Brouilly is smooth, harmonious, hearty, delicately fruity and rich. We recommend to taste this wine at 14 °C.
