



Chiroubles Domaine des Pontheux

History and terroir :

The domain is situated within the commune of Chiroubles, at a place known as Pontheux. It has been run by the MEZIAT family and handed down from father to son since 1889. The vineyards face south-south-west on fairly steep slopes; the vines are mainly worked by hand using traditional methods.

Tasting :

A garnet colour, surprisingly intense on the nose, with "sorbet vigneron" and blackcurrant aromas! This Chiroubles is also wonderfully expressive on the palate: delicious and hearty with mellow, unobtrusive tannins. An absolute delight! We recommend to taste this wine at 16°C.
