



<u>Pouilly-Fuissé Domaine du Bois</u> <u>Rosier</u>

History and terroir:

The soil is mainly clay-and-limestone, with limestone dominant in some places, which gives the wine its lovely mineral quality.

The steeply sloping parcels require particular attention.

The vineyards are grassed and regularly ploughed between the rows to help fight against erosion. The winegrower is a precise, clean, meticulous man who makes a wine in his image: this Pouilly-Fuissé is upright and pure.

Tasting:

This lightly-coloured wine offers fresh fruit and white blossom aromas enhanced with a hint of impulsive citrus fruit. Fruity and round but without any excess, the flavours are soft and lemony. We recommend tasting this wine at 11-13 °C.
