
*2nd wine of Château Malartic-Lagravière

Vintage

Beautiful dense, deep colour. The nose is intense, complex and distinguished, developing a pleasant fruity bouquet with good maturity and a delicate woodiness. On the palate, the attack is generous, full-bodied and rich. Very elegant, both in terms of tannins and aromas, a lovely fruitiness develops, accompanied by notes of leather, spices and undergrowth, all blended with exceptional balance. Very harmonious, the impression is of density, complexity and voluptuousness. The finish is long and vigorous. Overall, there is a fine, deep minerality.
